**Fabrication, Supply, Delivery, Installation and Commissioning of 08 No's of
Above Ground Horizontal Fuel Storage Tanks of 8000 Gallon Capacity for
Ceylon Fishery Harbours Corporation (CFHC)**

1. The Chairman, Department Procurement Committee (DPC), CFHC invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Fabrication, Supply, Delivery, Installation and Commissioning of 08 No's of Above Ground Horizontal Fuel Storage Tanks of 8000 Gallon Capacity each for Ceylon Fishery Harbours Corporation.
2. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB – Single Stage One Envelope Bidding Procedure) specified in the National Procurement Guidelines 2024 and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Guidelines.
3. To be eligible for contract award, the successful bidder shall not have been blacklisted. The qualification criteria for the eligible bidders shall include the following. (Additional qualification requirements are given in the Procurement Documents)

a) General Experiences

- i. The Bidder shall have a minimum of five (05) years' experience in the design and manufacturing, Supply, Installation and Commissioning of Fuel tanks over 3000 Gallons or above prior to the bid submission deadline
- ii. The Bidder shall also submit the original of registration issued under Public Contracts Act (PCA) No. (03) Of 1987

b) Specific Experience in contract of similar nature.

- i. The Bidder shall have completed at least twenty (20) contracts involving the supply, installation, commissioning of Fuel tanks 3000 gallons or above, executed in compliance with the applicable regulations and technical requirements of the Ceylon Petroleum Corporation (CPC) and carried out under the supervision, inspection, or approval of the CPC.

c) Average Turnover and Working Capital

The Bidder shall have achieved an average annual turnover of not less than Sri Lankan Rupees Thirty Seven Million (LKR 37,000,000) over the last three (03) financial years. In addition, the Bidder shall demonstrate a positive average working capital for the same three (03) financial years.

d) Quality Assurance

The Bidder shall possess a valid ISO 9001 Quality Management System Certification for fabrication workshop issued by an accredited certification body. A copy of the valid certificate shall be submitted as evidence of compliance.

e) Workshop Facilities

The Bidder shall operate its own workshop facility with required equipment (roller machines, welding plants & other required machinery) for the purpose of Fabricating & Repairing fuel tank. The Bidder shall furnish adequate transport facilities to ensure the safe and timely movement of equipment and components between the site and the workshop.

f) Financial Recourses

The Bidder shall demonstrate adequate financial capacity and access to liquid financial resources, including cash, credit lines, or banking facilities, amounting to not less than Sri Lankan Rupees Eight Million (LKR 8,000,000), to ensure effective execution of the Contract. Documentary evidence issued by a licensed commercial bank or financial institution shall be submitted with the bid.

5. A complete set of Procurement Documents in English may be purchased from CFHC office (address above para 4) by interested bidders on submission of a written request on a business letterhead, and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of LKR 3,500. The method of payment will be by cash.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address (above para 4) at or before 11.00 a.m. on Aug 11, 2026. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened soon after the bid closing in the presence of the bidders' representatives, who choose to attend at 11.00 a.m. on Aug 11, 2026. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the form of bank guarantee of not less than Sri Lankan Rupees Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (LKR 250,000).
7. A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at 10.30 a.m. on Aug 24, 2026 in the Conference Hall of CFHC. All interested Bidders may participate in the Pre-Bid meeting.
